Thursday – Mini Tour, 2:30PM TO 5:30PM

Tolar Windmill Farm and Bed and Breakfast

40+ windmills on 26 acres. Windmills are representative of actual mills used in this part of Texas. Each restored to original condition and functions as designed. Some mills are always in operation, new ones added as restored. May see restorations in progress. Great photo opportunities! Bring camera! Tour of farm is free but donations are gladly accepted.

Bluff Dale Vineyards

Come sit on the porch overlooking the beautiful vineyards and Hill county of Bluff Dale, Tx. They have been awarded First Place in the prestigious Tasters Choice Consumer's Wine competition held in Texas, as well as First and Third Place at Grapefest in 2012. Wine tastings are available, as well as soft drinks and light snacks. Beautiful views!

Friday – Mini Tours at 9:30am

Hico, Texas – Where everybody is somebody! A beautiful small town located on the cusp of the Texas Hill Country. Unique shopping is available in the historical downtown district. Learn of Billy the Kid and the history of Hico in the Billy the Kid Museum (free, however donations are gladly accepted). Wiseman House Chocolate offers fine handmade chocolates, a must stop here! On your own for lunch at the many different restaurants available: Chicken Express, Cowboy Kitchen Pizza inn, Eis Sandwich and Ice Cream shop, Giovanni's Italian Restaurant, Hart's Firehouse BBQ, Jersey Lilly's American and Mexican, Koffee Kup Family Restaurant (homemade donuts, pies and bread), Pita Place Sandwich and Soups and Sonic.

Saturday – Grand Tour to Meridian, Texas. This will be a beautiful back roads tour with plenty of twist & turns as well as a few low water crossings! SELF-GUIDED TOURS

Dinosaur Valley State Park – Walk in dino tracks embedded in the Paluxy River. State Park fees apply. A small amount of hiking required, wear shoes that you don't mind getting wet. Good photo opportunities and Gift Shop.

Fossil Rim Wildlife Center – experience a taste of Africa. Good up close and personal photo opportunities. Offers drive thru tours, behind the scene tours and educational opportunities. (1,700 acres, 1,000 animals, 50 species). First facility of its kind do be accredited by the American Zoo and Aquarium Association. Petting zoo and snack bar/restaurant available. Price is \$24.95 for adults and \$18.95 per child.

Oakdale Park – Opened May 1, 1925 and one of only 4 remaining motor courts in Texas. Lots of history here. Camping, bungalows, cottages, dance pavilion, beautiful 330,000 gallon swimming pool (one of the largest in the state). Bathrooms and concession stand available. Price is \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 per child.

Barnard's Mill and Art Museum – Historic Landmark – Free

Big Rocks Park

Creation Evidence Museum – The museum is 501©3 non-profit educational museum chartered in Texas for the purpose of researching and displaying scientific evidence for creation. Large scale replica of Noah's Ark. Good photo opportunities! Price \$5.00 per person, children 5 and under is free.

Dinosaur World – 20 acres of walkways that feature life-size dinosaurs and their history. A dino dig for children, playground and indoor life-size interactive walk through complete with motions and sounds. Gift Shop available. Price \$10.75 for seniors, \$12.75 for adults and \$9.75 for children.

Wheeler Branch Park – Opened August 7, 2010. Great fishing spot! Floating dock, beach area, fishing pier, restrooms, picnic area, pavilion, bird sanctuary, boating... No lifeguard on duty – swim at your own risk. Entrance fee is \$8.00 per adult, \$4.00 for children under 13. If you plan on fishing you must have a valid fishing license.
